2. अध्यक्ष महोदय ने सभी सदस्यों का स्वागत करते हुए बैठक का आरम्भ किया ।
3. The following issues were raised and solution made thereof :-

- i. Shri Arun Sharma, President, Rajasthan CHA Association raised issue to give LIFE TIME validity of Custom Brokers Licences .

In this regard, the worthy Commissioner stated that vide Public Notice No. 03/2022 dated 09.02.2022 this office has already intimated to all the CHA's that the intimation giving "Life time validity" of their licenses will be sent soon to their office addresses available on record and on their email address, which alone will be sufficient to extend their License validity to Life Time Validity. There is no need for Customs Broker to visit physically to get their license. Further Shri Sanjay Dhingra asked for copy of the said Public Notice, which was provided to them after meeting.

- ii. Dr. K L Jain, Secretary General Rajasthan Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Jaipur raised following point for agenda of the said meeting which were replied by Chair during the meeting. Issue raised & Clarification given for the said issues are as under:-

- a. Exporters are feeling great pain due to non-working of Air Cargo for General Goods Cargo.

The Chair stated that export/import of consignments for general goods are already being cleared from both Air Cargo Complex, Jaipur by M/s RAJSICO & M/s AAI CLAS. Further it is stated that total 646 exports and 938 import consignments of general goods were cleared in the last F.Y. from ACC, Sanganer by RAJSICO, Jaipur. Further they apprised the trade that M/s AAI CLAS and M/s RAJSICO (ACC) both are smoothly working and full functional for General Goods cargo & no such issue has been noticed by this office.

- b. New Cargo complex by Airport Authority of India (AAI) - Class although inaugurated, however it is not fully working.

The Chair apprise that Airport Authority of India (AAI CLAS) is working smoothly since its inauguration and total 09 SBs and 17 BOEs have been cleared till date. No system related issue has been reported to this office.

Further Shri Arun Sharma & other trade representative ie. Indigo, Spice jet stated that staff of AAI CLAS is neither sufficient nor so they have sufficient knowledge of Air Cargo working/procedures. In this regard the Chair intimated the facts to representative of AAI CLAS and Shri Edward Jarain, DGM (Cargo) AAI CLAS ensured to resolve the same at the earliest with consultation of their higher authorities.

- c. It is understood that Jaipur International Airport Ltd. cargo complex has been appointed custodian but where it is existing has not yet been notified.

The Chair stated that M/s Jaipur International Airport Ltd., Jaipur has been appointed custodian for the existing premises of Air Cargo Complex, Sanganer, which is currently being run by M/s RAJSICO and appointment will come with effect from 01.07.2022. Further on being enquired Shri Ajay Sharma representative of JIAL stated that they are further going to extend the time limit for one month for RAJSICO to vacate the premises of Air Cargo Complex, Sanganer till their system is in order.

- d. It is requested that the Custom Dept. should kindly appoint a Custom officer at ICD Sanganer on full time basis to facilitate exporters and importers which is run by RAJSICO at Sanganer.

In this regard, the Chair asked the jurisdictional DC/AC regarding the query, Smt. Parul Singhal DC, ICD RAJSICO, Jaipur explained that customs officers are already posted on full time basis vide their office order dated 25.05.2022 at ICD Sanganer to facilitate exporters and importers. Further, it was inquired by many trade representatives about non availability of staff then the Chair directed concern ADC regarding posting of additional staff in upcoming AGT at ICD, RAJSICO, Jaipur.

- iii. Shri Nitin Khandelwal, Deputy Director, GJEPC, Jaipur raised the issue regarding restarting Personal Carriage (Hand Carriage) of gems and jewellery from Jaipur and assessing readiness of New Custodians to handle G&J exports/ imports.

In this regard, the Chairman stated that the movement of Bonded export cargos such as Personal Carriage (Hand Carriage) was temporarily stopped by BCAS due to not granting passes to custodian for movement of parcels within Airport at the premises of Air Cargo Complex by M/s Rajsico, Sanganer only. Further, New Air Cargo Complex by M/s AAICIAS is permitted by BCAS for movement of cargo within airport. Further the Chair assured to resolve the issue with meeting of CISF & BCAS at the earliest.

- iv. Shri Edward Jarain, DGM (Cargo) AAI CLAS raised the issue regarding MOT charges after 6 PM but the trade representative stated that the facility should be 24x7 without any additional charges. Then the Chair asked AAI CLAS about availability of their staff for 24*7, the matter may be considered accordingly.
- v. Shri Bishawambhar Jha, representative of JGSE requested to chair regarding allotment of space for transit strong room at Air Cargo premises then the Chair stated that it is the matter of two commercial entities between Adani International Airport limited Jaipur and JGSE. Further, Shri Ajay Sharma representative JIAL stated that these decisions have already been taken up at higher level however if there are some commercial issues then the same may be resolved with consent meeting at appropriate form. Further, the Chair stated that department will ensure to provide smooth export/ import facility to trade during transition phase.

4. In addition to the agenda points some more queries were raised during PTFC meeting and their solutions made thereof

1. Trade representative asked for non availability of printer for printing of Shipping

Bills at ICD RAJSICO Sanganer, In the regard the chair stated that in EDI system the concern exporter is required to mention their designated E-mail ID., after processing the export, the shipping bill automatically generated and a e-mail is sent to the registered E-Mail ID by the systems. Thus, there is no need to print shipping bills. However in case of need it can be printed. ICD RAJSICO has been advised to look into the matter immediately.

2. Trade asked M/s Jaipur International Airport Ltd. for improvement of facilitation of the trade at the facility. In this regard Sh.. Ajay Sharma, from M/s JIAL politely asked all the trade representatives to offer their suggestions in this regard so that they will in-corporate them in their Master Plan.
3. Further the chair requested all trade representatives to offer their suggestions and feed back on FAG (Faceless Assessment Group) directly to Smt. Parul Singhal (Deputy Commissioner) ACC Sanganer, (being Member of the Committee) to further forwarding to Board.

Thereafter, the Chair thanked all the members for their deliberation. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair. Next date of the CCFC and PTFC meeting would be communicated well in advance.
