2. अध्यक्ष महोदय ने सभी सदस्यों का स्वागत करते हुए परिचय के साथ बैठक का शुभारम्भ किया
3. The following issues were raised and solution made thereof :-
- i. Hon. Secretary, Federation of Rajasthan Exporters raised following point for agenda of the said meeting which were replied by Chair during the meeting. Issue raised & Clarification given for the said issues are as under :-
- A. One of their Member M/s A L Paper House LLP is manufacturer & Importer-Exporter of Paper and all kind of paper products. During the import of raw material and machinery from overseas with a negotiated value from the supplier, at the time of examination custom officer calculates the price of goods with current market value and increases the import value to increase the government revenue and import duty which not only increases our cost but also increases the flow of Indian currency overseas. Further, during export the goods with higher value in comparison of the market value which enhance the flow of the incoming currency from overseas to India, but custom has issue that we get increased drawback amount which is just miniscule in comparison with the inward amount of foreign currency from overseas.

In this regard, Chair asked the jurisdictional DC/AC regarding the query, Dr. Parul Singhal, Deputy Commissioner of ICD, Kanakpura stated that vide BE No. 5877364 dated 17.10.2021 M/s A L Paper House LLP has imported used offset machine wherein value was loaded as suggested by Chartered Engineer and vide BE No. 5943200 dated 04.12.2019 importer has imported Waste Paper wherein value was assessed as per NIDB data and importer also submitted letter of consent. In respect to export made by M/s A L Paper House LLP, no shipping bill filed where export value was reduced.

Further, the Chair stated that the said issue is related to an individual party not a generalized issue. If the importer is aggrieved with the valuation of goods, then he may approach the Appellate Authority as per the provisions.

Action – No action required.

- B. One of their Member M/s. R K Textiles (A Govt. of India Recognized Star Export House) facing problems related to Drawback as the same is released too late, getting after 4 – 6 months. One DBK is pending from more than 8 months (shipping bill no.6841156 dated 18.12.2021). In few cases EGM data mismatch shows in shipping bill status due to this problem DBK is delayed. Shipping bills status in the DGFT site is not updated timely. Handling Charges by forwarders like B/L charges etc. are increased frequently; they should be fixed and regulated by government.

In this regard, the Chair has asked the details of the port from where the goods were exported. Representative of the federation stated that the goods were exported from Nhava Seva Port, Mumbai. The Chair stated that the said matter is not related to them and pertains to Nhava Seva Port, Mumbai and suggested that the exporter may submit a detailed note of the matter to this office. A reference may be forwarded to jurisdictional authority by this office.

Action – No action required.

- ii. Shri Arun Sharma, President, Rajasthan Customs House Agents Association, Jaipur raised following point for agenda of the said meeting which were replied by Chair during the meeting. Issue raised & Clarification given for the said issues are as under:

A. Deployment of any Plant Protection Officer at Jaipur Air Cargo Terminal

The Chair has discussed the said matter with the representative of AAICLAS for allotment of space. The representative of AAICLAS has assured to take up this issue in their upcoming Board meeting. Further, the Chair has assured to take up the issue with concerned authority.

B. Deployment of extra Customs officers at Air Cargo Terminal, Jaipur

In this regard, Chair asked the jurisdictional AC regarding the query, Smt. Anupama Saksena, Assistant Commissioner of Air Cargo Terminal, Jaipur stated that the sufficient staff strength have been deputed on the cargo terminal & they are clearing Shipping Bills regularly which are pending upto 07:00 PM. Further the Chair suggest to carry the cargo in the morning & file shipping bills in advance and if any information needed to be altered then update the same on the system. Further the chair has asked President, Rajasthan Customs House Agents Association, Jaipur to discuss the same with the trade as he suggests thereafter the said issue may be taken up in meetings.

Action – AC(ACC)

C. Working Conditions & infrastructure facilities at ICD, RAJSICO are not good -

The Chair advised the Assistant Manager, RAJSICO to improve the facilities. In this regard, Shri R. S. Dubey, Asst. Manager, RAJSICO stated that they have installed Air Conditioner & Water Pipeline. Further, Computer system will also be set up by them within a week. Further the said matter is related to two commercial entities however the chair has assured to take up the said matter with the concerned authorities of ICD, RAJSICO.

Action – AC, ICD RAJSICO & Custodian of ICD RAJSICO

- iii. Shri B. Jha, In-charge of Jaipur Gemstone Exchange, Jaipur raised following point for agenda of the said meeting which were replied by Chair during the meeting. Issue raised & Clarification given for the said issues are as under:

A. AAICLAS charging Import TSP charges for precious Cargo parcels meant for Customs Clearance from Jaipur Gemstone Exchange -

The Chair stated that it is matter of two commercial entities between AAICLAS, Jaipur and JGE, Jaipur and suggested that the matter may be resolved with consent meeting between both entities at appropriate forum.

Action – JGE & AAICLAS

- B. Jaipur Gemstone Exchange has a transit strong room at Air-site at Jaipur Airport. Now the ADANI, Jaipur International Airport Ltd. has given a notice to Jaipur Gemstone Exchange to vacate/handover the premises of transit strong room from Airport. Representative of JGE requested to chair for allotment of space for transit strong room.

In this regard, the Chair stated that it is the matter of two commercial entities between Adani International Airport Limited, Jaipur and JGE and suggested that the matter may be resolved with consent meeting between both entities at appropriate forum.

Action – JGE & Airport Authority of India

- iv. Shri Nitin Khandelwal, Deputy Director, GJEPC, Jaipur raised the issue of restart of personal carriage of Gems and Jewellery parcels from Jaipur Airport. Post opening of travel, there is an immense need for restarting the hand carries shipments to enable exporters to touch base their buyers for seeking orders and sale.

The Chair stated that vide Facility Notice No. 5-6/2013 dated 15.10.2013, the Customs Commissionerate Jaipur has been allowing the personal carriage of gems and jewellery export parcels from Jaipur International Airport, the facility of personal carriage is only available to foreign bound passengers using Jaipur Airport as Gateway port and boarding on international flights. Now, BCAS is not granting passes to Custodians (M/s JGSE) restricting their movement within the Airport while handling of such bonded export cargo for delivery to foreign bound passengers in the immigration area.

Thus, granting of passes to the custodian for movement in Airport is the matter between two independent agencies i.e. BCAS and M/s JGE, Jaipur. Decisions related to the matter may be resolved with consent meeting at appropriate forum. The custodian must meet with the norms and conditions of I-Class security for BCAS clearance or other requirements. They may approach the local BCAS office and request them for granting of passes after fulfillment of required criteria for security clearance or otherwise.

Action – JGE & BCAS

4. In addition to the agenda points trade representative raised the issue that sometimes AAICLAS deny to take the cargo claiming that they have no labour that time. In this regard, the Shri K. N. Yadav, DGM of AAICLAS stated that they initiated operations recently. The recruitment process is now completed & they assured to provide smooth import/export facility to trade within a month.

Action – AAICLAS

Thereafter, the Chair thanked all the members for their deliberation. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair. Next date of the CCFC and PTFC meeting would be communicated well in advance.
